OPENING REMARKS

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 am with a word of prayer led by Sheikh Ibrahim, The Manager welcomed the citizens to the meeting and expressed gratitude for their attendance. He later introduce himself, Municipality officers and the Board Members respectively.

MIN 1/5/32024: KUSP PROJECT

The Civil Engineer (Said Haji) presented a report to the citizens on the KUSP projects for the previous years i.e. Water Storm projects and Box Culverts within Mandera Municipality.

They then elaborated the report and informed the citizens that there is need for modernization

MIN2/5/2024. MODERNIZATION OF BUS PARK:

Discussion centered around the current state of the bus park and the need for modernization to improve facilities and services.

Concerns raised regarding safety, cleanliness, and accessibility were addressed.

Proposed solutions included upgrading infrastructure, enhancing security measures, and implementing efficient management systems.

Action Item: Form a committee to draft a proposal for the modernization project and present it to relevant authorities.

MIN3/5/2024 REHABILITATION OF WATER POINTS:

Community members highlighted the deteriorating condition of water points and the impact on access to clean water.

Suggestions included repairing existing water points, installing new ones in underserved areas, and implementing sustainable maintenance strategies.

Concerns about water quality and sanitation were also discussed.

Action Item: Establish a task force to assess the condition of water points, prioritize rehabilitation efforts, and coordinate with local authorities for funding and support.

MIN4/5/2024 CONSTRUCTION OF BODA BODA SHADE:

Recognizing the need to provide shelter for Boda Boda operators and passengers, discussions focused on identifying suitable locations and designs for the shade.

Considerations included accessibility, safety, and environmental impact.

Community input was sought regarding preferences for materials and amenities.

Action Item: Conduct a feasibility study to determine the most suitable location and design for the Boda Boda shade, involving stakeholders in the decision-making process.
